Steve Diehl moved to accept the minutes of the November 7, 2019 meeting as read. Fred Neumann seconded the motion and it carried.

Fred Neumann moved to accept the treasurers report with \$33,088.07 in the checking account. Cecilia Jones seconded the motion and it carried.

Jim noted Carlton County wishes to increase the grant amount. Beaver control is part of the reason.

The ESAB grant was tabled as Gary Allison was checking on Kettle River needs.

The simulator was discussed. Gary Allison is working on making it computer accessible to make it easier for the public to use.

The Coffee Lake Bridge was discussed. We need two 40' I beam that would cost about \$5,100.00 plus 3" decking that would be another \$3,000.00. Allison may have a semi-trailer opportunity that would be \$2,500.00 to \$3,000.00. Franklin Turnock moved Gary should pursue the trailer opportunity. Fred Neumann seconded the motion and it carried. There are some concrete blocks that could be put at the beginning and end of the trailer, as rocks don't stay.

Roger Bernhardt purchased a pull type grader that could be used in the Moose Lake/Kettle River areas on the trails. Liability insurance may be an issue. Would he be content with gas money? Jim Gassert will check with the DNR on options.

Erv Kleinschmidt has our banner.

Jerry Juutilainen would like to see markers every two miles on the trail so riders would know where they are. How many signs would it take? Can we use posts that are already there? Jerry will talk to Greg Berneau, Carlton County Land Commissioner.

Maureen Gassert moved to have Corey Eken cater our Holiday Get Together this year on January 18, 2020 at Tamarack Sno Fliers Club. Corey is a sponsor. Happy

Nominations were open for a three-year term Board Member: Steve Diehl nominated Jeff Bradford. With no other nominations, Steve Diehl moved to cast a white ballot for Jeff. Fred Neumann seconded the motion and it carried. Jeff is our Board Member until 2022.
