President Gassert called the meeting to order at 6:58 PM.

Stephen Diehl moved to accept the minutes of the June 6<sup>th</sup> meeting as read.

Bob Knauff moved to accept the treasurers report with a balance of \$22,017.94.

Phil Lippo seconded the motion and it carried.

Ross Wagner sent a copy of the flyer out for proofing. It should be available for the Carlton County Fair. We are working on prices for metal signs for Alliance Clubs.

Franklin Turnock reported on the six head counters put out in Aitkin County for a more accurate count of ATV traffic. The numbers in May were 3,223, in June 3,202 and so far in July 2,357.

ATVAM is requesting a donation of \$100.00 or merchandise of that value for the silent auction at the Ride and Rally this fall. Bob Knauff moved we give \$300.00. Debbie Yotter seconded the motion and it carried. He and Cindy noted they have 80 acres up there and if someone wanted to camp out, they would be welcome.

Carlton County is going to mark the trail in the Soo Pits.

Fred Neumann noted the roving crew from the state has been working on the Lawler Loops for the last two and a half days. There were fourteen truck loads of rock to be distributed on the trail. The outhouse by the Dead Moose was burned and Up North ATV Club needs a replacement. Roger Yotter moved the Evergreen P.A.C. donate our Porta Potty to Up North. Debbie Yotter seconded the motion and it carried.

The Soo Line was graded before the 4<sup>th</sup> of July. It needs to be done again in August.

Franklin Turnock will check with Mr. Perry on how the simulator project is coming. Will it be available for Carlton County Fair?

A letter from the Minnesota DNR came stating effective July 1, 2019: Youth must be at least ten years of age in order to take the safety education and training certification program and receive an all-terrain vehicle safety certificate; the certificate is not valid until the person reaches age 12.

Darlene sent a report to Operation Round Up for the \$1,000.00 given to youth for their certificates. It was suggested she send one to Lawler Area Community Club also.

Moose Lake will be hauling millings to improve the trail by the state prison at no cost to Evergreen P.A.C...

Gary Allison reported the Brown Road has a mile of swamp by 19 East. We're still waiting on Chris Johnson on the connection to Aitkin County.

Jerry Stone reported the trail from Carlton County to Lawler has tree overhang.

Cromwell requested signage "off road vehicle". Tom Johnson put them up.

The group that helps maintain the Soo Line would like an electric chain saw. The cost would be about \$600.00. Up North has one in their trailer they don't use. Maybe we can get it from them?

August 3, 2019 Carlton County Riders will meet at Kettle River on August 3, 2019 for a ride. They will be going to Axtell for a barbeque. You are invited to attend. Bring a dish to share.

Allison's are not planning a veteran's ride this year. Next year...
