Gary Allison found a semi-truck frame in Barnum for the Coffee Lake Bridge for \$1,000.00 It has tires on it and stake pockets. Jim Gassert noted we are not making a new bridge we are replacing a bridge. It is on state land and the DNR will give us permission to install the frame. Jim Gassert will tow it from Barnum to Moose Lake. A workday to set it up can be scheduled.

Aitkin County had 7,000 ATV maps printed.

We had 2,000 Carlton/Pine ATV brochures printed.

Kevin Turnock moved we write a letter to sponsors extending their sponsorship to 2021. If any new sponsors sign up, they will get the rest of this year and 2021 free. Debbie Yotter seconded the motion and it carried.

Sponsors will be getting signs noting RIDE RIGHT RIDE SOBER. Jim Gassert will hand out signs to Doc's Sports Bar and Grill, Duquette General Store, Gampers,

Lazy Moose Grille, Moose Lake Municipal Liquor, and Squirrel Cage. Franklin Turnock will hand out signs to Buckhorn Bar and Grill, Kangas Enterprise, and Pour Leweys. Signs have already been handed out to Moose Lake Implement and Jackson's Hole in Lawler.

Pine County Journal and ATVAM Magazine had articles on Carlton County Riders planting trees and adding signage to the landfill area near the Soo Pits. The purpose was to prevent renegade riding on the area prohibited for riding. Great job!

Jim Gassert will put up signage in the pits toward the freeway saying, "No ATV".
