Eric Senrighti, President of Carlton County Riders thanked us for the prop trailer. He also gave us an update on what their club is doing in the Carlton area. There will be a Youth Training on September 29, 2018. They would like to promote "Lids for Kids" and are still working on the way to best share safety gear.
