Tony Kangas hauled 300 yards of material on the truck trail. Aitkin County is picking up the tab as Carlson Logging did the damage. Kangas is scheduled to grade the trails before Labor Day and before the Ride and Rally.

The logger in the Soo Pits didn’t go to the top so the trees weren’t taken care of. The cat was in the pits and it’s looking good.

Darlene presented information of the insurance issue. Jim and Darlene will take care of it.

We still need silent auction items for the 2017 Fall Ride and Rally. South Metro has offered to get items. Polaris will send something to Jim. Jim's son-in-law donated a sign. There are map boxes at the Soo Pits and by Rita's Rock.

The DNR atlas will be available by middle August now.

Jim will be ordering 150 shirts for the Ride and Rally registrants.

There is a big washout by the Kettle River Bridge near Denham. It's in Pine County and Jerry Stone and Roger Bernhardt will call and make them aware of the issue.

The 2017 Fall Ride and Rally early deadline registration will be September 10th. It will cost \$35 at that time and \$40 after the 10th. You can preregister and pay at the door.
