Evergreen P.A.C. ATV Club Meeting – June 1, 2017 - Jackson's Hole in Lawler

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by President Gassert.

Jerry Stone moved to accept the minutes of the May 4, 2017 meeting. Jim Ackland seconded the motion and it carried.

Carmen Rinta moved to accept the treasurers report with \$5,605.56. Ed Raisanen seconded the motion and it carried.

Gale Bradford reported the ATV Youth Training was a success with 100 youth trained. There were three hundred volunteer hours contributed by Evergreen members. There was a question on if the ads in the papers were beneficial or if the participants went online to find the classes. It was decided to drop the ads for next year. Franklin Turnock suggested sending thank you's to Long Lake Conservation Center and to Tamarack Sno Flyers for the use of their facilities. Gale brought left over hotdogs for sale. (\$1.75 cooked/\$3.25 frozen)

Jerry Stone will check on the price of using the Moose Lake Depot. It's supposed to be less when ran through the community education program at school.

No updates on Carlton County and Aitkin County Roads. It was noted when the county roads are opened the clubs could lose state grant and aid funding.

Jerry Stone and Greg Jones will sell raffle tickets at the Dirty Chicks Ride Saturday.

Kangas Enterprises graded the Soo Line Thursday before Memorial Day Weekend. It's in good condition. There is a low spot by the Aitkin/Carlton County line.

CO Brent Speldrich handed out warning tickets to dirt bikers. Following the laws is an education we encourage.

There needs to be cut work done on the N/S trail before the airport in Moose Lake. The Soo Pits need rock spread. A culvert should be installed in the Soo Pits at the turn around. Gary Allison moved to pay Jim Gassert for hauling his dozer to the pits. Ed Raisanen seconded the motion and it carried.

The 45' telephone poles in Cromwell were discussed. Franklin Turnock will pick them up. Jim Gassert has access to new poles from MP&L. We need three by Gampers.

Jim Gassert had signs made for Cromwell depicting "ATV's Slow". Franklin Turnock will pick up 4 "Do Not Enter" and 4 "One Way" signs from Aitkin County.

Eric Senarighi moved to have 1,000 Carlton/Pine ATV Trail maps made. He amended his motion to 2,000 maps and Franklin Turnock seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Eric Senarighi noted the Polaris Ride Command is a good advertising tool for businesses. A person from the club can make changes electronically and include points of interest.

The new Northwood maps are out.

Barnum Spring Fever Days are June 10th.

The Hill Toppers ATV Club is looking for volunteers to man the booth at the Mud Nationals in Hill City.

There is also an opportunity to man the ATV booth at the state fair.
